Interview: "We have bet on scientific expertise"

As mentioned in our <u>June 2012 e-newsletter</u>, the **Cour de Cassation** (French Supreme Court), in a **decision** dated **May 30, 2012**, **dismissed** the **appeal** lodged by the **civil parties** against the **judgment** of the **Toulouse Court of Appeals** having **confirmed** the **dismissal** of the **much publicized bee case**, thereby putting a **final end** to this **legal saga**.
